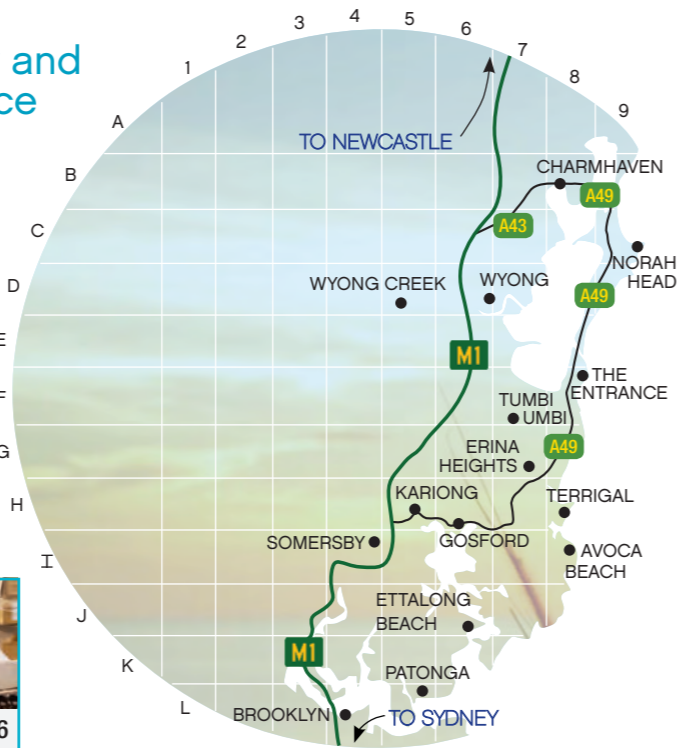

On your bike! This ride contours the southern edge of Tuggerah Lake along approx 10kms of shared pathways with plenty of places to stop and admire the views. **Next Stop:** 20 minutes to The Entrance



Crackneck Point Lookout • G8
